Sizing & Numbering of Images: As Shawn Carey has secured a meeting location for us at Wellfleet Bay Wildlife Sanctuary on April 28th, he will be doing the projection of images there. If you plan to show images, here are the sizing and numbering instructions that he recommends:

- Please name your images with your name (esmith) and a number. Make sure there are at least always 2 digits even for the single digit numbers.

Like this:

esmith01.jpg

esmith02.jpg

esmith03.jpg

...

esmith10.jpg

esmith11.jpg

....

this will make sure your images are ordered correctly when they are displayed because Lightroom will sort by name which it can easily do.

- I would recommend resizing your images to match the projector we are using. It has a resolution of 1920 x 1200.
